Imagine the territory with the most extensive river network in Italy: an area of more than 9,000 kilometres that can be fished with one single permit, where there are no private waterways and where no one farms fish except for eggs or juvenile fry.

If you are imagining a maze of rivers flowing through wild and uncontaminated terrains, which gently give way to wide rivers at the bottom of the valleys and then to peaceful lowland resurgences where marble trout, brown trout, hybrids and wild grayling swim free to reproduce, you are simply thinking of the Dolomites and the Carnic Alps.

The Paradise of Marble Trout was created thanks to the collaboration of seven Municipalities that are linked by a joint territorial development project associated with recreational fishing. The Friulian Dolomites, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the Carnic Alps, where gentle hills and majestic peaks invite you to experience nature in its purest form, are just two hours from Venice.

The Regional Fisheries Heritage Protection Agency (Ente Tutela Patrimonio Ittico - ETPI) is the main Regional Authority for the management of fish in all our waters. It performs its mission with the highest standards of respect for the delicate balance that regulates river ecosystems. For many years, ETPI has undertaken projects to safeguard and repopulate the river environment of Friuli Venezia Giulia through the introduction of eggs and juvenile fish, in particular marble trout (Salmo trutta marmoratus) and grayling (Thymallus *aeliani*), limiting the release of adult fish to a limited number of specific sites.

Following the challenges of the first years of this project, our rivers, which are not always easy to approach, now boast a population of wild fish with a strong majority of marble trout and the spawn of many native brown trout.

Here we still have Alpine streams where wild graylings breed in crystal clear waters, and where the deep blue colour blends with the green of century-old forests of wild and stunning beauty.

Imagine being free to chase wild fish surrounded by pure and untouched nature... your fishing holiday is here!

We introduce you to the seven Municipalities: Sappada, Forni Avoltri, Paularo, Arta Terme, Sauris, Forni di Sotto, Forni di Sopra.

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Sappada is a charming village dating to the early Middle Ages. It lies on the border with the Veneto Region at 1,250 m. Nestled in the Dolomites, the village attracts visitors with the charm of its breathtaking natural surroundings and the joyful liveliness of its traditions. The origins can be traced to approximately the year 1000. According to an old legend, it was founded by some families from the village of Villgraten in Tyrol, who fled from the tyranny of the Counts of Heinfels. An ancient dialect of the German language ("*Plodn*") is still spoken in Sappada to this day.

TRADITION

There are 15 hamlets in town ("*heivilan*" in the local dialect) spread across the valley floor, each one a short distance from the next. The wooden houses have a unique rural architecture. They were built using the ancient technique of "*blockbau*" (logs stacked horizontally and interlocked by means of notches). The town has a rich history, with festivals and local traditions. It is home to many interesting tourist facilities and cultural points of interest: the Ethnographic Museum, the House of Agricultural Civilisation, and the Small Museum of the Great War.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

The Carnival ("*Vosenocht*"), one of the most traditional events, involves typical wood-carved masks, which are masterpieces of local craftsmanship. The celebrations take place on 3 consecutive Sundays after the pagan festival.

THE SOURCES OF THE PIAVE RIVER

The river springs at the foot of Mount Peralba, 1,830 metres above sea level, in the northeastern corner of the Dolomites, between Cadore and Carnia, along the border between Veneto and Friuli Venezia Giulia.

Upstream, the *Piave River* is dominated by torrents, but later, before reaching the town and for almost its entire length, it becomes flat, with small pools and wide open clearings. This is where the river bed is characterised by relatively coarse gravel, with many boulders and rocks of different sizes, which counteract the currents and create small bends. Before reaching the border with Veneto, the *Piave River* flows into a gorge called the *Orrido dell'Acquatona*.

Thanks to its natural flow, the *Piave River* is very popular with anglers who use artificial bait, and especially fly and spin fishing enthusiasts. With its clear and transparent waters, the river delivers powerful emotions. 9 Km RIVERS AND TORRENTS

THE ACCURACY OF CASTING ARTIFICIAL LURES FROM A DISTANCE

Because of its peculiar characteristics, the *Piave River* can challenge the angler's ability to cast accurately in certain spots.

To avoid alerting the fish to our presence, it is advisable to fish at a respectable distance.

The *Piave River* attracts anglers not only because of its large population of brown trout, which, due to the nature of its waters, can reach considerable sizes, but also because of its rich and fascinating natural environment. The *Piave River* is the most Sacred of all the Rivers of the Nation.

NO KILL ZONES

The *Piave River* — From the waterfall upstream of the first inhabited old mill at the beginning of the Sesis Valley to the dam in front of the Municipal sports field.

The stretch running through the town of Sappada presents shallow waters and swift currents, interrupted by small pools and some long stretches of calmer waters: this is where trout are likely to be discovered, settling on the banks or under some vegetation, sheltered from the rays of the sun.




RECREATIONAL FISHING

The artificial *lake of Ziegelhütte* is located at 1,186 metres above sea level, very close to the *Piave River*. It is a beautiful green artificial pool on the banks of the *Rio Storto* stream. The lake is surrounded by the pine woods of the Digola Forest and the first ridges of Mount Col dei Mughi.

The site is equipped with fishing rods and bait available for hire. Permits are issued exclusively at the *Baita al Laghetto* facility.

FORNI AVOLTRI Along the banks of the *Degano Torrent*

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Forni Avoltri is located in the breathtaking setting of the Carnic Alps. It stands on the slopes of Mount Coglians (2,780 metres above sea level), the most elevated peak in the entire area, which includes most of the highest mountain groups in Friuli Venezia Giulia, geologically the oldest in Europe.

It is called the "town of water" because of the presence of several streams, lakes and an infinite number of springs.



TRADITION

The existence of a "*furno*" (furnace) in this area, used for smelting and processing the ore extracted from the mines of Mount Avanza, is documented to 778 AD. Originally the kingdom of the *Carni*, who were of Celtic origin, the territory later passed under the rule of the Republic of Venice, the Napoleonic Empire and the Austro-Hungarian Empire, before becoming part of the Kingdom of Italy. The "*Cemut chi èrin*" Ethnographic Collection and the Great War Museum are definitely worth a visit to learn about the history of this town.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

The Festival of Forest Fruits - On the last Sunday in July, the union of the culture of food and wine with nature. *The 3 mountain huts relay race* - A spectacular international team mountain running competition, held on the first Sunday after August 15. *Presepiando* - An event dedicated to handicrafts, with an exhibition of nativity scenes in the villages.





THE DEGANO TORRENT

Forni Avoltri is located in the upper Degano Valley (northwestern Carnia) and it is crossed by the *Degano Torrent*. The *Degano Torrent* springs in the area of the village of Pierabech (1,039 metres above sea level) from the confluence of three streams: the *Fleons*, the *Avanza* and the *Bordaglia*.

The waters of the *Degano Torrent* are characterised by large pools, mostly

at the foot of the dams, where trout usually rest on the banks or just below the falls.

The *Degano Torrent* is marked by a succession of typical rapid water courses and small clearings. The riverbed is made up of gravel and large boulders that cut through the rapids and form pools of various sizes in which trout can be found hovering in search of food.

LAKE BORDAGLIA

It is one of the most striking alpine lakes of the western Carnic chain, a body of water of glacial origin that lies at 1,750 metres above sea level in a basin at the foot of the Creta di Bordaglia mountain range.

It is a wildlife oasis of incomparable beauty, inhabited by numerous animal and plant species.

Nestled between the grey ridges of the Volaia Mountains and the green ridges of the Fleons Peaks, *Lake Bordaglia* is a must for people who love unspoilt nature.

NO KILL ZONES

People who cast their line into *Lake Bordaglia* can be sure not only of a good catch but also of an experience of total relaxation in contact with nature. The wealth of fish species, the purity of the water, the beauty and diversity of the landscape: the *Degano Torrent* is protected with a No Kill zone from the bridge of the State Road S.S. 355 to the bridge of Via Belluno in the town of Forni Avoltri. This guarantees a large number of spectacular fishing spots.





SPECIAL FISHING CONDITIONS

If you want to enjoy an unforgettable day fishing in the best spots, the *Degano Torrent* is particularly suitable for fishing marble trout, which are subject to restocking, and also for some wild brown trout. The best area is from the bridge on Via Belluno in the town of Forni Avoltri to the power station near the confluence with the *Rio Fulin* stream.

All types of fishing techniques can be practised here depending on the spot, from light and ultralight spin fishing to fly fishing and natural bait fishing.

AAA **PAULARO** An alpine basin surrounded by peaks and forests

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Situated in the centre of the d'Incarojo Valley, Paularo is a popular tourist destination because of its unspoilt natural environment and the many opportunities it offers for high-altitude excursions.

Of particular interest are the *Salino Waterfall*, a spectacular 30-metre drop just outside the village, and the *Las Callas Gorge*, which is crossed by an equipped trail that starts from the Cason di Lanza pass.

TRADITION

The town centre is graced by *Calice Screm Palace*, an architectural complex with characteristic overlapping galleries, considered to be the prototype of the Carnic house. Another attraction is the 18th-century *Linussio Fabiani Palace*, the residence of the family of Jacopo Linussio, founder of one of the largest textile companies in 18th-century Europe.

Well worth a visit are the *Mozartina*, a valuable collection of ancient and modern musical instruments, and the

Ecomuseum, which recreates the working environments and techniques used in the old days of the d'Incarojo Valley.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

Mistîrs - An exhibition of traditional trades and crafts along the town streets, with folk music, food and drink. *La Femenàte* - One of the most picturesque spectacles involving ancient rituals of the Epiphany. *Len* - A day devoted to the world of wood, with sculptures and typical woodwork.





THE D'INCAROJO VALLEY

The territory of the Municipality of Paularo is located in the eastern part of Carnia, in the area known as the d'Incarojo Valley, also called the Chiarsò Valley or the Paularo Valley. The upper part of the *Chiarsò Torrent* has the morphology of rushing natural rapids, with large boulders; along its course, it crosses some gorges, but it also contains some very deep pools that are set against rocky walls and that are rich in marble trout.

The stretch of the river that runs through the town is characterised by large pools at the foot of the dams and some shallow clearings.

THE CHIARSÒ TORRENT

The lower part of the *Chiarsò Torrent* takes on the characteristics of downstream rapids with swift currents broken by wide clearings and a riverbed made of gravel and sand. The lower basin of the *Chiarsò Torrent* is currently the subject of a study (2024) to restore the population of graylings to the levels of years past.



PAULARO The river basin



NO KILL ZONES

There are two No Kill zones in the *Chiarsò Torrent*. The first starts from the dam at the village of Rio and ends at the bridge at the entrance to the town of Paularo (which is called "Ponte di Ferro," or the Steel Bridge). The second No Kill zone runs from the Rinc Bridge to the Cedarchis Bridge.

The *Chiarsò Torrent* has always been a well-known and popular destination for both experienced and amateur fishing enthusiasts.



SPECIAL FISHING CONDITIONS

The dedicated area is the *Rio Mueia* stream stretching from the *Rio Pecol* (or *Vintulins*) *Waterfall* to the confluence with the *Chiarsò Torrent*.

It is known by competitive and amateur anglers for its scenic beauty, excellent water quality and, above all, because it is populated by magnificent salmonids.



FISH RESTOCKING ZONES

Particular attention is paid to the Restocking Zones that, in the area of Paularo, involve the *Rio Benedet* and the *Rio Cascata* streams, which run from the Salino Waterfall to the confluence with the *Chiarsò Torrent*; and lastly, the *Rio di Trelli* stream, which flows from its source to the junction point with the *Chiarsò Torrent*.

AAA ARTA TERME An ancient mountain and the fair

LOCATION AND HISTORY

At 442 m MSL, Arta Terme is a small village in the heart of the Carnic Alps, inside the But Valley. Appreciated for its Spa with a modern wellness centre that exploits the beneficial effects of the waters of the *Pudia Spring*, it was famous as early as the Roman era.

TRADITION

Arta Terme unites the beauty of the mountains with the advantages of low altitude and offers a holiday of wellness

combined with the finest gastronomic tradition of Friuli Venezia Giulia. In the small local shops, visitors can purchase honey, cheese, typical Carnic "*cjarsons*", plum and pear liqueurs. A rich network of footpaths along the valley floor allows for pleasant excursions on foot, by bicycle and on horseback. In the hamlet of Piano d'Arta, it is well worth visiting the parish church with its unique octagonal shape, the 13th-century small Church of San Nicolò degli Alzeri and the Church of Santo Spirito in Chiusini.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

Festival of herbs and spring mushrooms -The third Sunday in May. *The Cjarsons Festival* - In the Rivalpo Valley, the first Sunday in August is dedicated to the typical traditional dish

from Carnia. *Plum Sunday* - In Cabia, on the last Sunday of September, a celebration of fruit and territory linked to the production of excellent liqueurs for centuries. *La Femenate* - In Piano d'Arta with the winter solstice. Celebrations tied to the rites of purification by fire.





11 Km RIVERS AND TORRENTS

THE CHIARSÒ TORRENT IN THE HAMLET OF PIEDIM

Also called "*Darte*" in the Friulian language, it is located in the But Valley, in the Alpine region of Carnia. The *But Torrent* springs from the southeastern slopes of Mount Coglians and, after a short distance, makes an abrupt turn to the south, flowing into the wide alluvial plain that was once Lake Moscardo. These waters reappear in full downstream in a basin, the ancient site of another lake. Near the town of Arta Terme, the torrent cuts a narrow riverbed between the dolomite, sandstone and gypsum sedimentary rocks, which leads to an additional enrichment of sulphate ions in the waters of the *Tagliamento River*. The *But Torrent* then runs for seven kilometres to the Tolmezzo basin, where it merges with the *Tagliamento River*, forming a large alluvial fan.

CRYSTAL CLEAR WATERS TEEMING WITH FISH

The *But Torrent* is born from the confluence of the *Rio Chiaula* and the *Rio Collinetta* streams, which descend from Mount Crostis (2,251 metres) and the Pass of Mount Croce Carnico (1,360 metres). This watercourse is exceptionally beautiful with its sand and gravel banks and the many brooks that feed it with pure spring water.

Experience a unique adventure in the tributaries of the *But Torrent*: a popular spot for both fly and spin fishing, where you can catch extraordinarily beautiful marble trout!



ARTA TERME The river basin



NO KILL ZONES

In the area of Arta Terme, the *But Torrent* is a large alluvial plain consisting mostly of gravel, where there are large clearings and deep pools, especially near the dams.

There are two No Kill zones included in the area of the *But Torrent*. The first is in the Municipality of Paluzza, from the "Ossario" bridge downstream to the bridge next to the sports field; the second is in the village of Arta Terme, from the outlet of the Nigris hydroelectric power station to the intake of the hydroelectric power station.



SPECIAL FISHING CONDITIONS

In the *But Torrent* from the Sutrio bridge to the entrance to the former Noiaris tunnel, and from the outlet of the Terzo di Tolmezzo power station to the confluence with the *Tagliamento River*, you can experience various fishing spots in a wide variety of diverse habitats, which are particularly appreciated by fly fishing enthusiasts.



FISH RESTOCKING ZONES

Please be aware of the Restocking Zones at the *Rio Confine* stream, from the bridge of the old provincial road to the confluence with the *Chiarsò Torrent*; and along the *Rio Poi* stream at the village of Piedim, from its source to the confluence with the *Chiarsò Torrent*.

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Located in the mountain region of Carnia in the Lumiei Valley, its territory is home to an artificial lake, one of the largest in Friuli: *Lake Sauris*. An Alpine oasis where visitors can find peace, excellent food, traditions and open-air living, thanks to a rich calendar of outdoor activities. Nestled in the mountains on the border between Carnia and Cadore, this area embraces the flow of the seasons to the rhythm of nature, between the soft alpine pastures

in summer, the fiery foliage of the trees in autumn, the snow on the typical houses and the colourful explosion of the meadows in spring.

TRADITION

In 2022, Sauris was included in the List of Best Tourism Villages by UNWTO 2022, a United Nations initiative that rewards destinations where tourism preserves local traditions and culture while safeguarding the environment and biodiversity.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

The *Carnival* with its lantern walk and wooden masks. The *Prosciutto Festival* is dedicated to this exquisite, cured meat delicacy, which is produced locally, and the *Accordion Festival* echoes through the streets of the town in July. The *Festival of Alpine Cheese and Small Fruits* in August is an explosion of flavours and traditions. The *Culture Days of Sauris*: unique and historic events celebrating the ancient culture of Sauris. The *Festival of Flight* in September.





LAKE SAURIS

Created by an artificial dam in the 1950s, it has a domed structure that, at the time of its construction, was the second highest in Europe (136 metres). The lake is periodically drained and, on these rare occasions, the spectacle of the ancient village of *La Maina* emerging from the water captivates and amazes visitors. The shores of the lake are generally easily accessible, but in many places, the water level is not always constant and fluctuates according to the flow of water at different times of the year.

INTENSELY BLUE

Travelling up the narrow Lumiei valley, where human engineering has enabled the road connection between the valley floor and the municipality of Sauris, or crossing the overhead road of the Pura Pass, visitors reach the lake where the surrounding multicoloured heights are reflected beautifully.

An Alpine lake where countless outdoor activities are perfectly at home: recreational fishing, canoeing or windsurfing. Not to mention the pure adrenalin rush of the ZipLine, which is one of the longest and most exciting in Italy.

NO KILL ZONES

A steep path leads to a gravelled clearing of the *Novarza Torrent* riverbed passing through a narrow bottleneck enclosed by rock walls.

This is the No Kill zone that runs from the source of the *Rio Novarza* stream to its confluence with the *Lumiei Torrent*. A unique opportunity to experience a fantastic and spectacular landscape.



RECREATIONAL FISHING

It seems almost impossible that in just a few minutes' walk you can reach such magnificent and magical places as the Gorge of the *Lumiei Torrent*, which is about fifty metres deep. This destination is home to many unique and exciting places.

FORNI DI SOTTO

The domain of the Savorgnan family

LOCATION AND HISTORY

The history of the town is unique. For a long time, together with Forni di Sopra, it was part of the autonomous area known as *Forni Savorgnani*, the domain of the Savorgnan family, who were granted the land by the Patriarchs of Aquileia. Its name comes from the word "*Furno*," which means "furnace", used for the smelting of minerals; in ancient times the metals extracted from the mines of Mount Avanza were processed in this area.

FVG Fishing Lodge

HOTEL ***ALBERGO DIFFUSO

Completely destroyed by the Nazis in 1944, who set it on fire in retaliation, Forni di Sotto still preserves the wells of the three former hamlets into which it was divided. After the war, the town was rebuilt around these wells.

TRADITION

The "*Zîr dai Cristins*" (Tour of the Cristins) is a walk along the valley floor to discover the local history and culture. The "cristins" are small churches or votive chapels built by private families as votive offerings to ask for protection and prosperity.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE / THE FRIULIAN DOLOMITES NATURAL PARK

The small church of San Lorenzo, frescoed with one of the most important cycles by Gianfrancesco da Tolmezzo, a 15th-century Friulian painter, is definitely worth a visit.

The town is the ideal starting point for excursions to the peaks of the Upper Tagliamento Valley and walks in the Friulian Dolomites Park.

The *Festival of the Three Hamlets* - An event celebrating food and wine and the revival of traditions.





A RIVER THAT STRETCHES ACROSS THE ENTIRE ARC OF THE ALPS

The *Tagliamento River* at Forni di Sotto features a gravel riverbed that spreads over a very wide alluvial plain, where strong currents are interrupted by large flats and pools of varying depths. This location provides anglers with an unforgettable experience of nature and wild fish, especially native species. Further downstream, in the area of Caprizi, the *Tagliamento River* is under study for the reintroduction of grayling.

THE VALLEY OF CRYSTAL CLEAR WATERFALLS

The *Poschiadea Torrent* rushes down between Dolomite boulders, carving out natural pools of pure water, where trout roam in search of food. The riverbed is formed by the narrow channel that runs from Mount Chiarescons down to the *Tagliamento River*, with gravel and large boulders that forcefully cut through the fury of the water, creating waterfalls and bends of different sizes.

SPECIAL FISHING CONDITIONS

The most natural areas require some walking to reach, but the effort is well rewarded by the beauty of the habitat and the quality of the catches, as well as the pleasure of being able to fish all day long, even in the very hot season. Enjoy the cool waters of the *Tagliamento River*, from the stretches surrounding the hamlet of *Acqua Pudia* to its confluence with the *Rio Marodia* stream.



RECREATIONAL FISHING

Forni di Sotto offers anglers a multitude of streams and some alpine lakes, in a unique and enchanting setting, where brown trout and arctic char find their ideal habitat.

The best spots for fly fishing in the *Tagliamento River* are precisely in Forni di Sotto. Here, in the heart of the forest, an equipped area has been created for people who love this activity.



FISH RESTOCKING ZONES

The *Rio Poschiadea* stream, from its source to the hydroelectric power plant; and the *Rio Sfuarz* stream, from the ETPI fish farm to the confluence with the *Tagliamento River*.

Studded with spires and pinnacles, a UNESCO World Heritage Site

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Framed by the splendid peaks of the Eastern Friulian Dolomites and located in the heart of a wide and sunny basin, Forni di Sopra is located in the eastern part of the Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, one of the largest and most picturesque in the Alps, and one of the richest in wildlife.

TRADITION

The houses are typically built in stone and wood, with staircases and balconies.



HOTEL ***MOUNTAIN HUTS

There are numerous churches in the hamlet of Cella, while the rural hamlet of Andrazza is known for its houses with adjoining barns and stables. The remains of the Sacuidic Castle can be seen here. The small rural museums housed in the oldest houses in the village are worth a visit: the 17th-century *Ciasa dai Fornés* and the 19th-century *Casina di víc*. Of particular interest are the murals on the walls of the houses, painted by the artist Marino Spadavecchia, which represent the life of the mountain communities of the past.

EVENTS AND FOLKLORE

The Spring Herb Festival - In June, one of the most popular festivals in the mountains of Friuli Venezia Giulia which is entirely devoted to wild herbs. *The Mushroom Festival -* In September, featuring guided walks with mycological experts and naturalistic tours to discover the flavours of the forest. A variety of sports competitions at altitude and along mountain trails, from the *Trail of the Alpine Pastures* to the *Sky Trail Race of the Friulian Dolomites*.





THE TAGLIAMENTO RIVER

The source of the river is northwest of the village of Forni di Sopra (Udine). It is the last great river in central Europe that still flows freely. Its gravel bed can even be seen from satellites, creating a real gateway for migratory species. The *Tagliamento River* flows for 178 kilometres from the Friulian Dolomites to the Adriatic Sea and its source is near the Mauria Pass. It is called the "King of Alpine Rivers" because of its high hydro-morphological quality and the uniqueness of its river ecosystem. It is an ecological corridor linking the Alpine region with the coastline of Friuli Venezia Giulia and Veneto.

THE SMALL LAKES OF VARMOST

The Small Lakes of Varmost are close to the arrival of the first section of the chairlift. These waters are managed by Pesport Dolomiti and are the ideal spot for recreational fishing. A special restocking area with brook trout (Salvelinus fontinalis), a real treasure for experts and experienced anglers. Depending on the season and accessibility, visitors can enjoy fishing with both artificial and natural bait.

SPECIAL FISHING CONDITIONS

The *Tagliamento River*, from its source to the Enel power station in the Municipality of Forni di Sopra.

The *Tolina Torrent*, from its source to the confluence with the *Tagliamento River*, also in the Municipality of Forni di Sopra, which changes its characteristics and flow rate as it moves downstream, is considered a first-class watercourse for fishing salmonids.





RECREATIONAL FISHING

There are two picturesque lakes in the town park, fed by several springs. Recreational fishing is permitted in these pools.

The lakes are constantly restocked with rainbow trout (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*). What better place to spend a few peaceful days fishing, surrounded by pine forests and the backdrop of the Dolomite massifs?





INSTRUCTIONS

Fishing is permitted from the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in September throughout the district, except for the possibility of fishing until October 15, but only in the NO KILL mode.

An exception is made for Lake Sauris, Lake Verzegnis and Lake Cavazzo, where fishing and the possibility of keeping salmonids is extended until October 31.

In the TRA sections, fishing and the possibility of keeping salmonids is permitted from the first Sunday in March to December 31.

The Regional Fisheries Heritage Protection Agency (ETPI) is the only authority in charge of the management of fish resources in the inland waters of Friuli Venezia Giulia.

Sport fishing is open to everyone. Fishermen without an FVG fishing licence can fish by paying the infra-annual fee.

Anglers are required to consult the Recreational Fishing Calendar. When fishing, you must have your fishing licence (if applicable), proof of payment of the fee, the annual or semi-annual registration document (DRA/DRI) and an identity document with you at all times.

How to travel to Friuli Venezia Giulia





BY CAR

Two motorways connect to the territory of Carnia. A23 Alpe-Adria, by taking the Carnia exit and A27 Venezia-Belluno, by taking the Pian di Vedoia exit. From here, drive on State Road SS52 Carnica, the main route to reach the Municipalities of Sauris, Forni di Sotto and Forni di Sopra.

Variant SS52bis leads to Arta Terme and Paularo, while Regional Road SR355 leads to Forni Avoltri and Sappada.

BY TRAIN

The main railway stations are Carnia and Calalzo di Cadore. These are followed by Udine, Pordenone and Sacile. Railway services are provided by Trenitalia and Italo.

BY COACH/BUS

Urban and extra-urban routes connecting to and from Carnia with Dolomiti Bus or TPL FVG.

BY AIR

The airport of Ronchi dei Legionari (Trieste) is located in Friuli Venezia Giulia, with connections to both Italian and European destinations. The nearest airports:


